

BIG BOAT DAY

The morning session (9 am – noon) is for the OPTI 1B and OPTI 2 Junior Sailors.

The afternoon session (12:30 pm – 4:30 pm) is for the 420 LTR and OPTI 3LTR.

The date is Wednesday, 23 July. In case of inclement weather, the backup date would be Friday, 25 July.
