Organizing Authority	Thames Yacht Club
Date	May 29, 2006
Rules	The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing., US Sailing Prescriptions and the sailing instructions.
Starting Line	Thames River at the Queen Merry, off the TYC clubhouse.
Classes	Classes will be assigned by the Race Committee according to PHRF numbers and hull design. One design classes of three or more entrants will be established. This is a non-spinnaker event.
Ratings	PHRF Ratings as assigned by PHRF of Long Island Sound. Attach copy of 2006 PHRF certificate. Time-on-Time handicapping will be used except for One Design classes.
Race Info	Skippers' Meeting at the Thames Yacht Club at 1030, Monday, May 29, 2006. Sailing instructions, scratch sheets, and course charts will be available there, and from the Race Committee on the Queen Merry prior to the first warning. The Series will consist of up to 5 races. Courses designed to give short, medium and longer distances.
First Warning	1200. First Start: 1205. The RRS 26 starting sequence will be employed. Subsequent races will be started as soon as possible using the RRS 2 starting sequence.
Courses	Courses will be determined by the Race Committee and posted on the Queen Merry course board.
Scoring	The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing, shall apply. Completion of any 1 of the scheduled races shall constitute a series. All races will be scored with no discards.
Ties	Race ties and Series ties shall be resolved in accordance with RRS, Appendix A, Rules A7 and A8 respectively.
Trophies	1st, 2nd, and 3rd for each class with at least five (5) entries. For Thames Yacht Club members the results will be consolidated with the Fall Chowder Series for combined awards.
Presentation	Race results will be announced at the Clubhouse after the final race. Trophies will be awarded at the Thames Yacht Club Skippers' Night on Friday, September 8, 2006.
Entry Fee	\$25 per boat payable to "TYC". Add \$3 if the skipper is not a member of US Sailing.
Entries Close	1200 Monday, May 29, 2006.
